CT Image Reconstruction

- Relates 2D FT of image to 1D FT of its projection
- NB 2D FT is “k-space” of MRI One of the most fundamental concepts in CT image reconstruction

if the “Central-slice” theorem This theorem states that the 1-D FT of the projection of an object is the same as the values of the 2-D FT of the object along a line
